\* "Semester Research Project" is a project run throughout a semester under supervision of a chosen tutor, whose result is a short philosophical essay (often called "semester essay")

\*\* student has to choose one of the following options:

- (1) passing the exam at (at least) B2 level provided that the language of the exam is NOT English;
- (2) passing the exam at (at least) C1 level (it can be English in such case).

The language of the exam cannot be student's mother tongue either case.

\*\*\* "Diploma seminar" is a course consisting of 60 hours of a monographic seminar (chosen by student) and individual student's consultation with a supervisor of student's diploma thesis. To pass the course student has to pass the seminar and submit a diploma thesis. Although it is accounted after the 6th semester student starts participating in her/his diploma seminar during the 5th semester.
